## **Pilehead**

**Breda** - The bulk of work is currently done by workers from Blijleven Sloopwerken, where they have been busy for the past few weeks with manual cutting of 295 Olivier piles on the Dr Struycken square. A length of 2 to 2.5 metres must be removed from the foundation piles that vary in length from 12.5 up to 17 metres. The piles, made by Verhoef Funderingstechnieken, are

being lengthened to ensure that the end results required from the piles can be guaranteed.

Because the piles stand close to each other a hydraulic cracker cannot be used. "There's a lot of work, but it is going quite fast," said Ludo Peeters, project leader at the internal services of the Dutch Construction Union (NBU). He expects that all of the piles

will be at the correct length within one week. The construction company has built three buildings on the square with 211 apartments available for sale or for rent, including a residential tower of 48 meters high. Shops, offices and social facilities are available on the ground floor.
